I. Answer the following questions.

1. Describe how to remove the background using the Chroma Key.

Ans. For removing background using Chroma Key follow the steps

1) Go to the effects tab and drag the Chroma Key (Green Screen) effect onto your Video clip.

2) Click the small "c" icon on the clip to open the properties panel.

3) Double-click the Key Color property, use the eyedropper tool to pick the background color (usually green) from the preview window.

4) Adjust the Fuzz Value to clean up the edges until the background is fully removed.

2. What is transition? How can we add it between two Videos in Openshot?

Ans. A transition is a Visual effect that

Smoothly moves the Viewer from one video clip to the next.

We can add two videos in Openshot by overlapping two clips on the same track in the timeline. Openshot will automatically create a transition (blue rounded rectangle) in the overlapping area. Alternatively drag a specific transition from the transition tab onto your clips.

3. What is the Keyframe effect? How is it used?

Ans. A Keyframe defines the starting or ending point of any smooth transition of a property (like position, scale or opacity) at a specific point in time.

When you change property at a specific timestamp, Openshot automatically creates a 'Keyframe'. By setting different values at different points, the software "animates" the change between those two points.

II Competency based Question:

1. You wish to combine clips of balloons,

gifts and a dancer playing at once.
Where should you arrange these clips?

Ans: We should arrange these clips on different tracks in the timeline. By stacking the clips vertically on separate tracks (e.g. Track 1, Track 2, and Track 3) they will play simultaneously.
