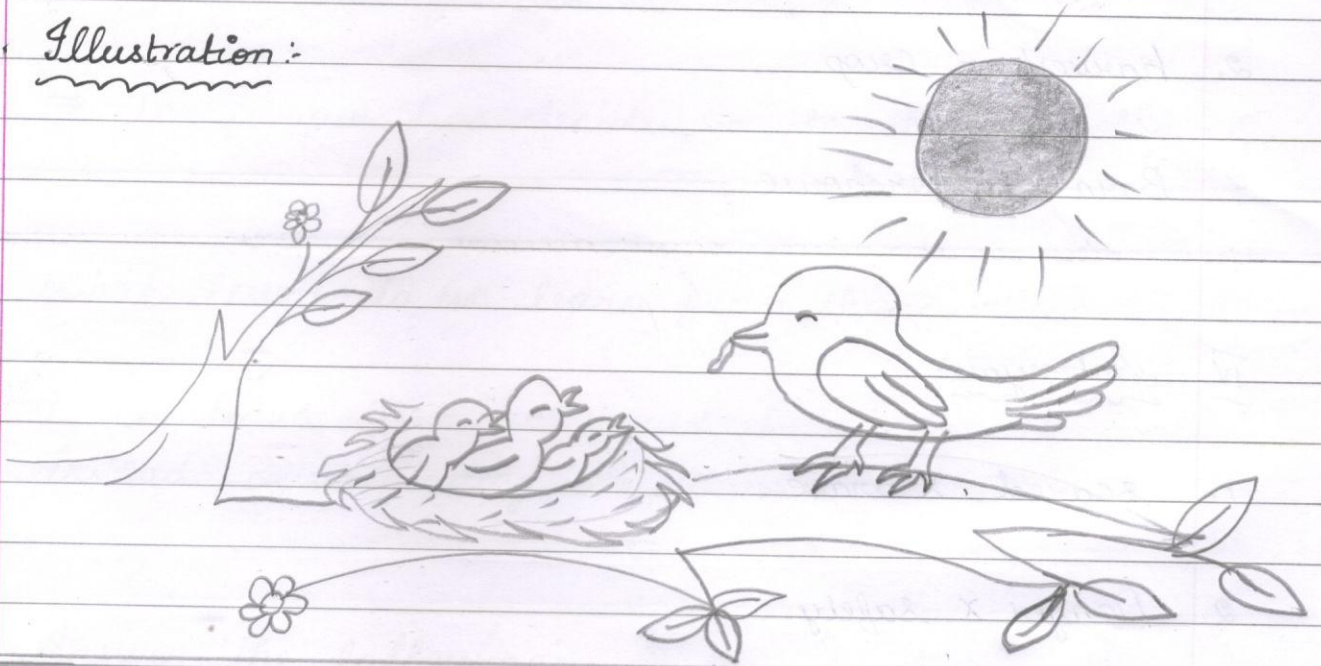

⇒ The farmer's relatives did not come to help because they were busy with their own work.

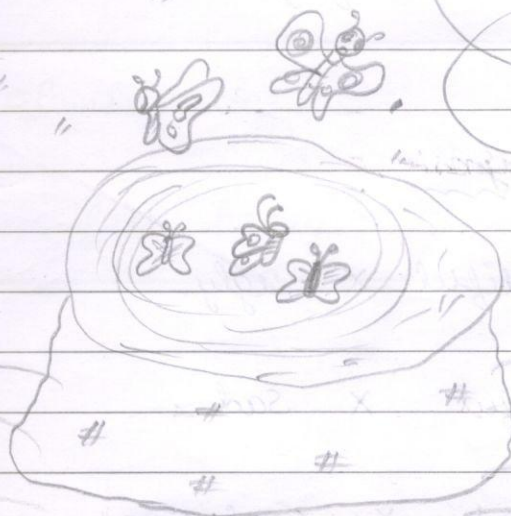
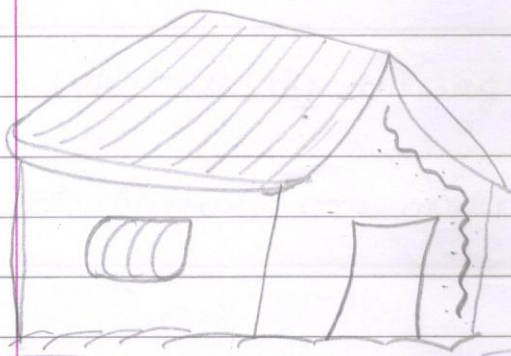
6. Why did the Mother Lark decide to move her nest?
