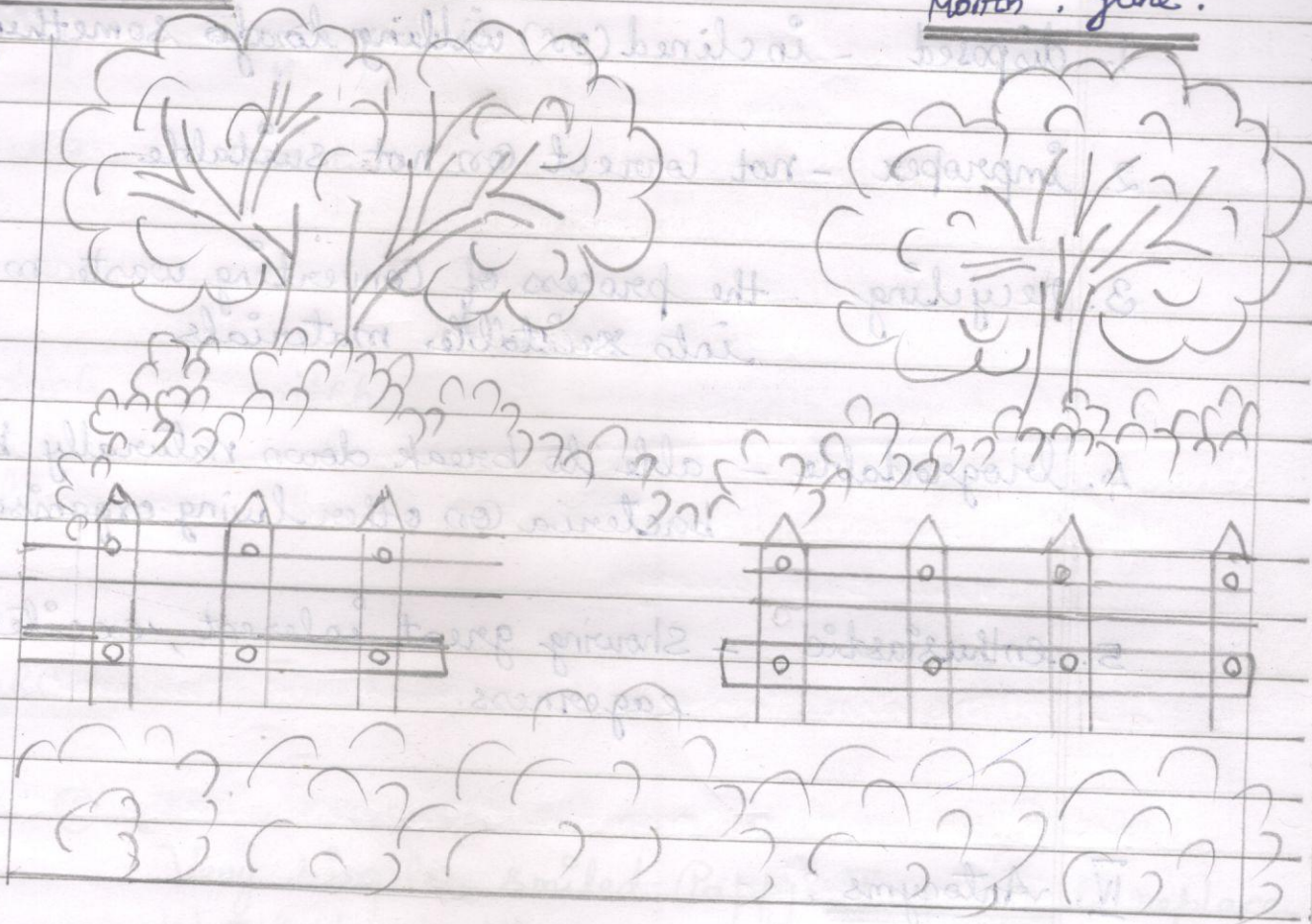


A Paper Bag Called Pappy.
