5. What lesson do we learn from the story?

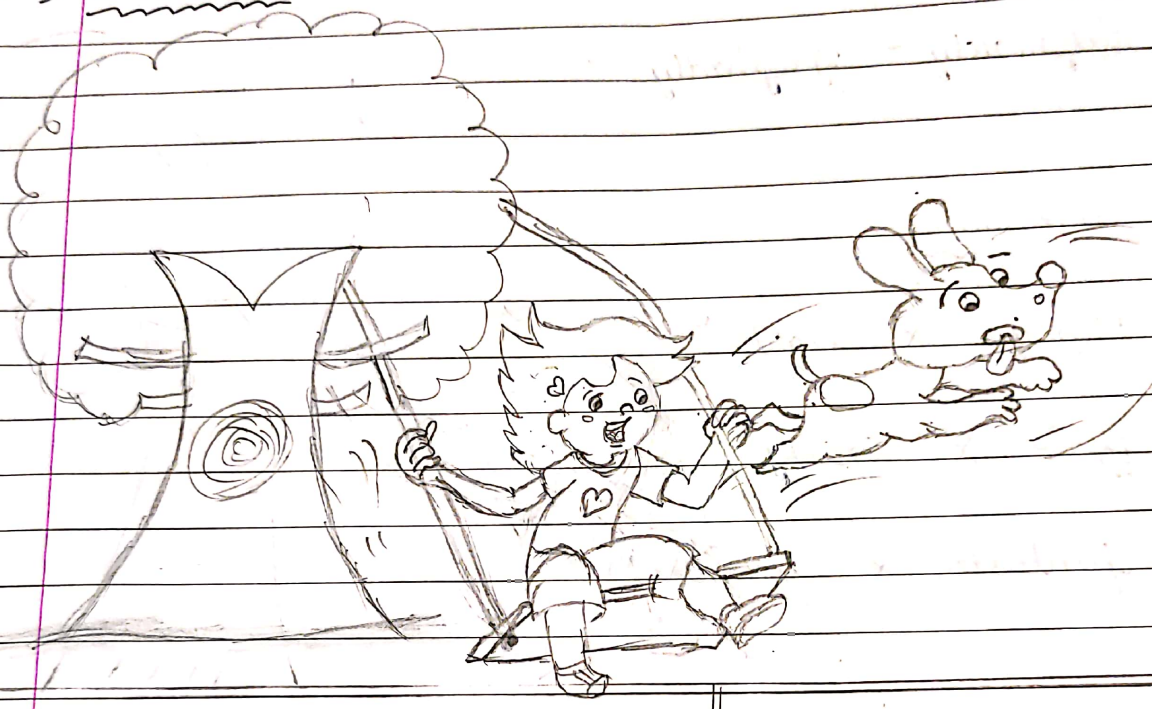
