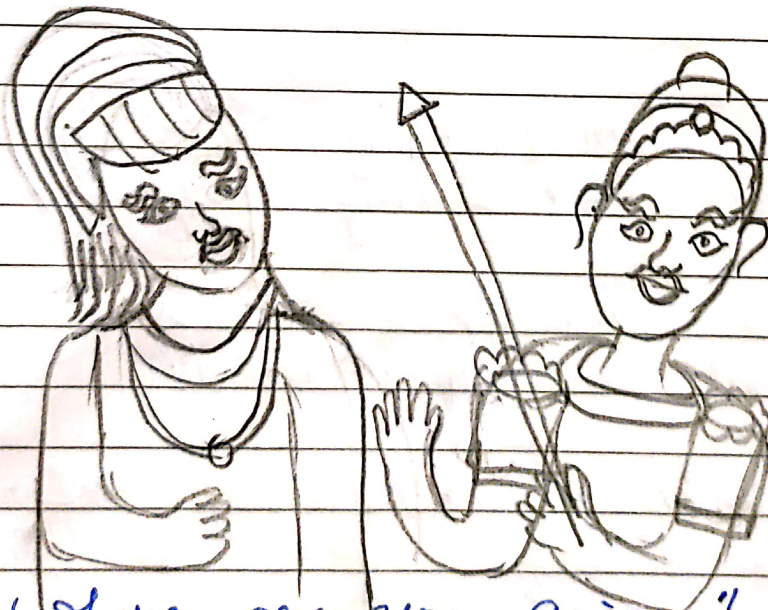

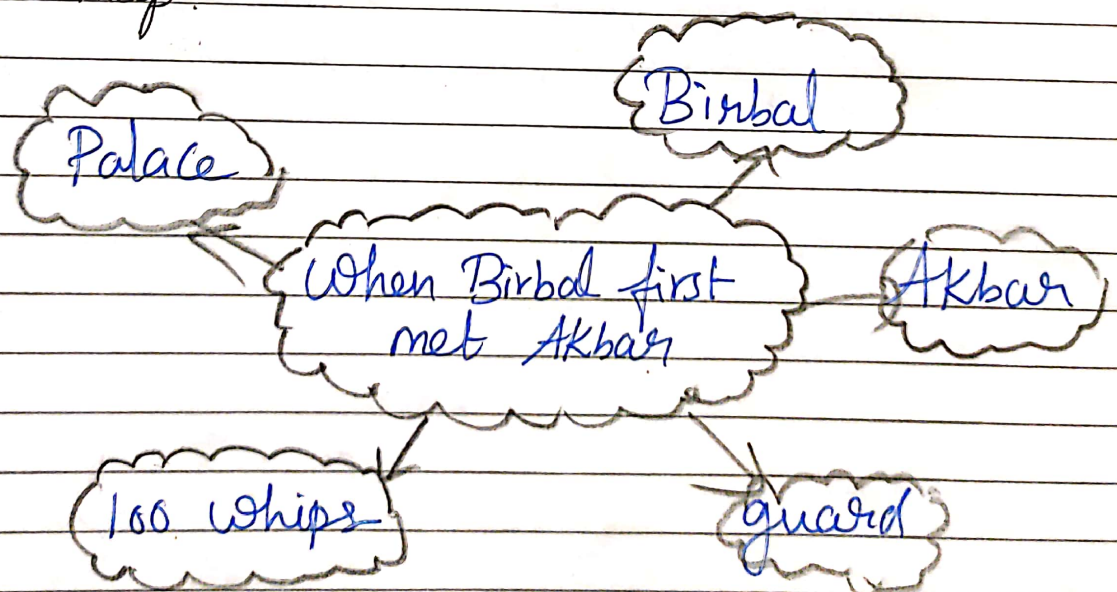
Ans: "your Majesty" refers to Emperor Akbar.

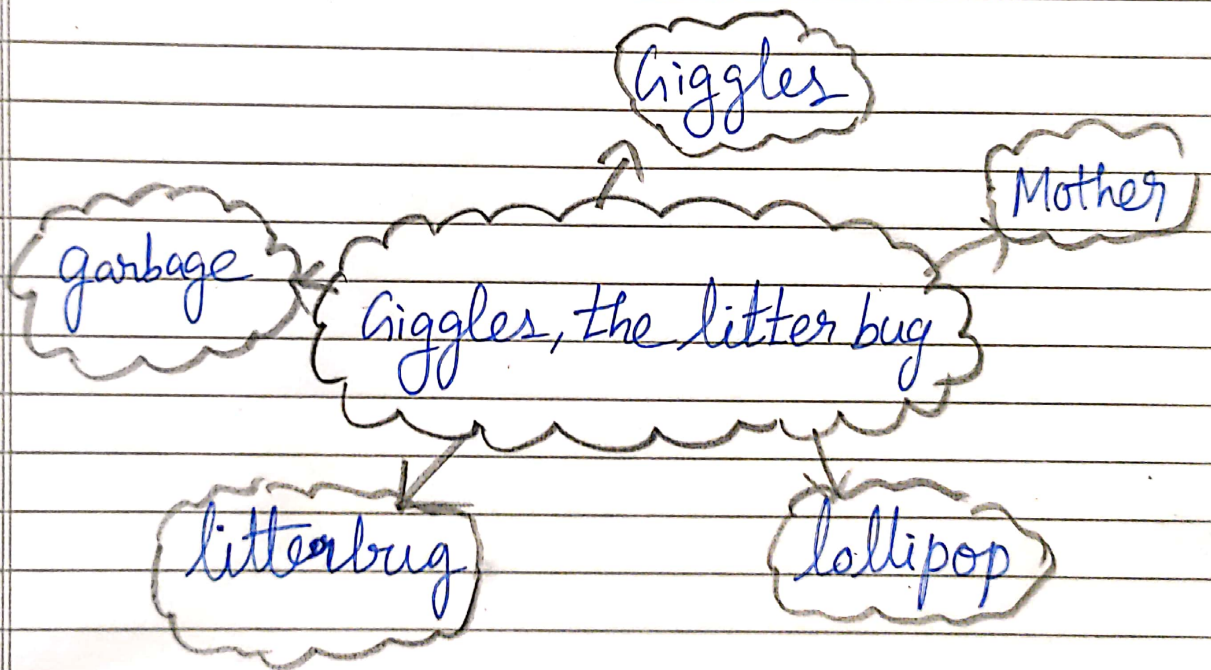
